PUBLIC COMMENTS INVITED ON THE PROPOSED EXTENSION OF THE FALSE BAY WHITE SHARK CAGE DIVING OPERATING AREA - NEAR STRANDFONTEIN BEACH

The Department of Forestry, Fisheries, and the Environment will embark on a public consultation process for the proposed extension of the False Bay White Shark Cage Diving operating area. The proposal was published by the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, Ms Barbara Dallas Crecy, for public comment on 2 September 2022 in Government Gazette 46847.

The reason for the proposed extended area is to provide support to the White Shark Cage Diving (WSCD) business sector in False Bay which has seen a significant decline in its business operations resulting from the current disappearance of Great White Shark sightings at Seal Island and the increased presence of other shark species (such as the Bronze Whaler) in inshore areas near Strandfontein Beach. The decrease in WSCD business operations has also negatively affected the tourism sector in Cape Town as tourism businesses that are inherently linked to WSCD tourism activities have also been greatly impacted, such as Bed & Breakfasts, hotels, restaurants, and tourism businesses. The proposal is, therefore, to temporarily mitigate the negative impacts on the tourism sector in Cape Town, by extending the WSCD area of operation closer to the inshore area where other shark species are found. This will allow the WSCD operators to continue operating by diving with other shark species.

The proposal is to allow WSCD operators to attract sharks in the newly extended area using chum and other methods to attract other shark species still present in the bay, such as Bronze Whaler Sharks. If Great White Sharks return to the bay in numbers previously recorded during the 2010/2011 seasons, the new area will be closed and the WSCD operators would be required to return to their normal area of operation around Seal Island.

A series of additional physical consultation meetings to discuss the proposal will be held during the month of October 2022, details of which will be published in the media.

Any person who wishes to submit representations or comments in connection with the proposal is invited to do so within 30 days from the date of this advert and by no later than 16:00 on the last day. All representations and comments must be submitted in writing to the Deputy Director-General of the department. Comments received after this date may not be considered.
